South African Law Reform Commission reviews legislation administered by the DSD

The South African Law Reform Commission (SALRC) has published a discussion paper on the revision of legislation administered by the Department of Social Development (DSD) for public comments.

The aim of this review is to ensure that all pieces of legislation that are administered by the DSD are compliant with section 9 (Equality) of the Constitution and to identify redundant and obsolete provisions.
